Our goal each season is to provide our Club with paramount service as we begin our new year in 2025! Our start into this new year has begun with colder temperatures as we hope to have some milder days ahead in order to keep the greens uncovered. The greens crew has done an excellent job keeping your course clean of leaves and debris in order to make our winter golf more enjoyable. Please adhere to the daily cart rules and remember to keep your carts 30 feet away from the greens and surroundings. Carts should remain on the paths around all teeing areas as well as all of our par 3 holes. Traffic in these areas can retard the growth of our bermuda grass as it comes out of dormancy in the spring. We will only restrict play to cart paths when necessary. Our golf course is making great progress in recovering turf in our playing areas, so please acknowledge any directed cart rules that may apply for a given day.

The off season is a great time to start or continue a fitness routine. There are many exercises for golf and low impact cardio to keep our bodies in shape through the winter. Staying consistent with a good routine will pay great dividends for your golf game as well as your everyday well being. Yoga is probably the best exercise we can do for flexibility, strengthening and stability.

Danville Golf Club Dress Code

<u>UPPER LEVEL (Unless otherwise approved by the Board prior to event)</u>

- For events prior to 5:00 PM, men are asked to wear dress slacks or khakis and a collared shirt or button down shirt tucked in. Hats, denim, T-shirts, and shorts are not permitted.
- For events prior to 5:00 PM, ladies are asked to wear dresses and skirts of an appropriate length, or dress slacks/business suits. Hats, denim, Tshirts, and shorts are not permitted.
- For events after 5:00 PM, sport coats are requested for men.
- For social events associated with a golf event, golf attire is permitted. Hats must be worn front facing at these events and golf shoes should be removed prior to entering the Clubhouse.

LOWER LEVEL (Unless otherwise approved by the Board prior to event)

- Appropriate golf attire is permitted in the 19th Hole prior to 6:00 PM. Hats must be worn front facing. Denim, that is free of holes, is permitted for men and ladies. Dark shades of denim are strongly preferred. All collared shirts or other styles commonly accepted as golf appropriate should be tucked in. Tshirts, athletic wear, and swim wear are not permitted.
- Hats are not permitted after 6:00 PM.
- Members/Guests under the age of 21, are not permitted in the 19th Hole Bar or adjoining room at any time.
 Members/Guests under the age of 21, may dine in the 19th Hole Dining Room or the Family Dining Room located in front of the Board Room.
